## **Japanese Cookery**

**A short course to learn the basics of  
authentic Japanese cuisine**

No previous knowledge of Japanese Cookery is required and everyone is welcome.

Japanese cuisine is uniquely refined and subtle. Come and learn the basic skills needed to produce authentic Japanese dishes. This course will introduce students to the Japanese way of cutting and garnishing to produce authentic dishes. (No dishes contain raw fish.)

Dishes include:

- Prawn Tempura
- Sushi
- Chicken Yakitori
- Teriyaki

All ingredients for the first session are provided by the tutor and are not included in the cost of the course. Payment for these will be made to the tutor on the day. Students will be told what ingredients to bring for subsequent weeks.

Students are required to bring an apron, a clean tea towel, a small sharp kitchen knife and between 3 and 5 food containers to take home completed dishes.
