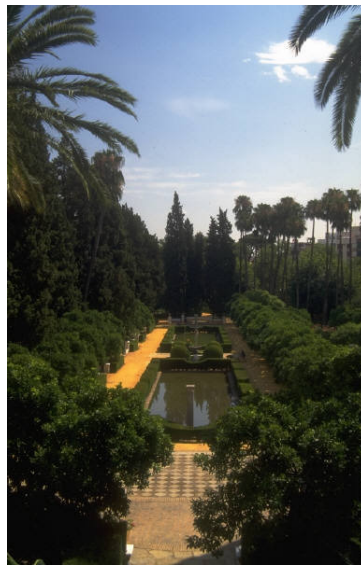

Introduction to Garden Design

An introduction to the theory of garden design, and garden design as a creative discipline

For the garden enthusiast who would like to learn more about the theory of garden design, and garden design as a creative discipline.

Each session will consist of illustrated talks, some on aspects of garden design, some focussing on influential gardens, as well as practical group activities to help reinforce the theory. The course will cover the history of garden making, practical considerations, principles of good design, style, planting design and colour, water features and lighting, landscape and the law, and more! Although not a horticultural course, the qualities of different plants will be discussed in the context of their role in 'clothing' the garden.

You will need:

Pencils - soft and hard

Coloured pencils - 3 colours minimum

Paper - A3 layout pad

Protractor

Scale rule with 1:50, 1:100 and 1:200 scales

(available from art/graphics shop - £2.50 upwards)

Other materials for models to be discussed with tutor.
