This course aims to encourage students of all ages to enjoy creating an item in the media of wood, or learning some basic woodworking related DIY skills, such as putting up shelves.

Students will learn basic skills to enable them to design and make an item of their choice and ability. This will include preparation of materials, setting out frameworks and structures, preparation for gluing and assembly, cleaning up and finishing. Techniques will be taught by demonstration to the group or on a one-to-one basis.

As students work individually on their own choice of projects, many aspects of woodworking can be covered. The course is suitable for complete beginners, or more experienced woodworkers.

Students may prefer to learn woodturning, although spaces for this are limited, so please specify on enrolment if you would prefer this option.

The materials required will depend on the choice of work. The tutor can advise further on this during the first session if necessary.
