Notice to Candidates

These notes have been written to help you and to ensure that you know the rules.

Please read carefully and make sure that you comply with this information.

1. Check and highlight your examinations: date, paper, time, place.
2. Arrive for the exam 20 minutes before the start of the exam.
3. Line up in the bus bays, in candidate number order, within the tier of entry you have been placed.
4. MOBILE PHONES ARE STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. THERE WILL BE AN INVIGILATOR IN THE PROJECT AREA IN THE 20 MINUTES LEADING UP TO THE EXAM. YOU MAY HAND IN YOUR PHONE, FOR WHICH YOU WILL BE GIVEN A RAFFLE TICKET. YOU MAY THEN HAND THE TICKET BACK IN AFTER THE EXAM TO COLLECT YOUR PHONE. THE IDEAL SOLUTION IS TO LEAVE IT AT HOME.
5. You must not talk to, or otherwise communicate with, or disturb, other candidates once you are inside the examination room.
6. Bring only the equipment you need for that exam with you **-PENCIL CASES MUST BE TRANSPARENT.**
7. Use only **black ink** when completing your answer papers.
8. No candidate may use correcting pens, fluid or tape, highlighters or pale coloured gel pens,
9. You must not borrow anything from another candidate during the examination.
10. No candidate may be in possession of any unauthorised equipment in the examination venue.
